2.3.4.	<p>“The Bidder has, in the past 5 (five) years prior to the date of the publication of this Invitation to Bid, procured, deployed and configured wired Local Area Network’s in at least 500 separate locations under up to 3 (three) successfully completed contracts. The wired Local Area Network, in sense of this requirement, means structured cabling system with at least 10 Ethernet ports.</p> <p>In case the bid is submitted by a joint venture (group of bidders), the requirement is fulfilled by all members of the group members cumulatively. This means that one or more members have procured, deployed and configured structural cabling under up to 3 (three) successfully completed contracts, for at least 500 locations combined.”</p>	Signed certificate of the Contracting Authority or the Beneficiary or other relevant documentary proofs (e.g. acceptance letters)
